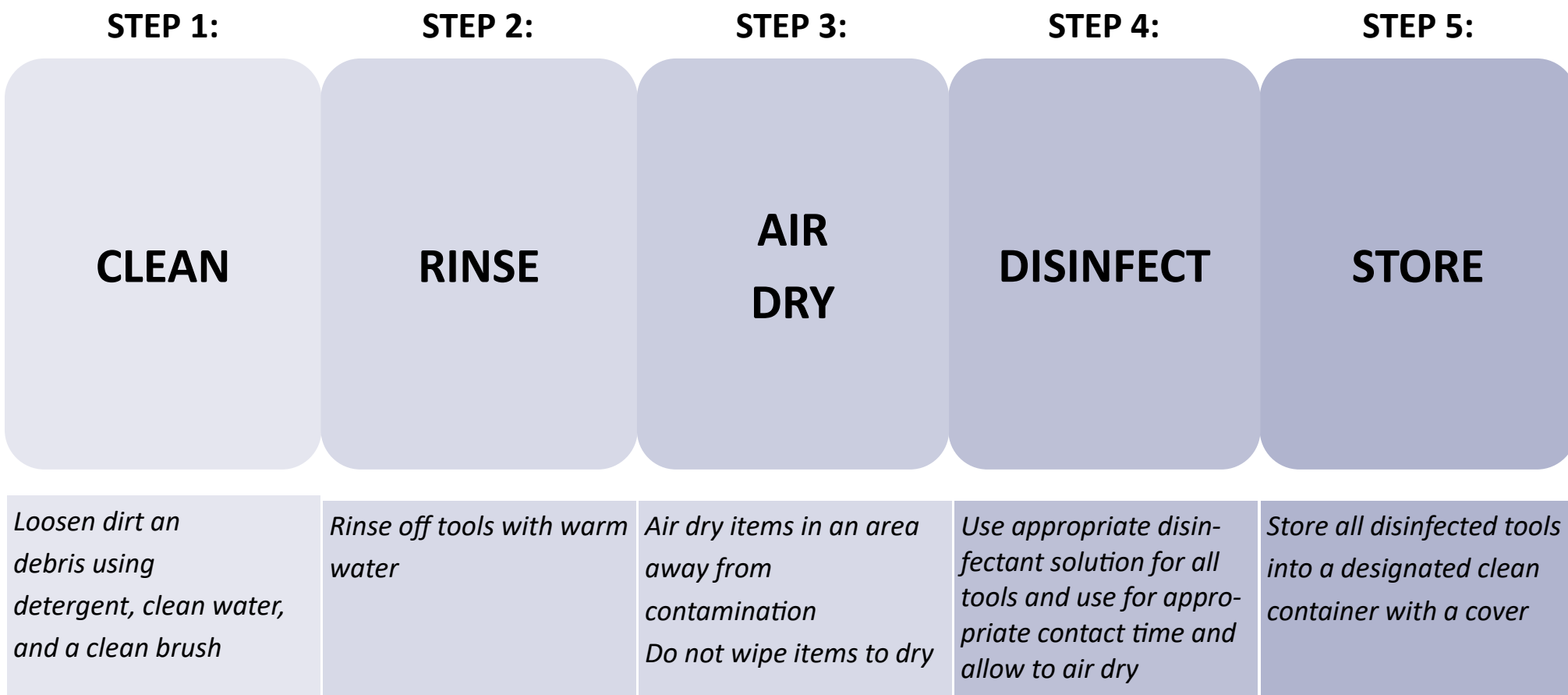


PERSONAL SERVICE SETTINGS: CLEAN, DISINFECTION FLOW CHART

All reusable tools and surfaces must be cleaned and disinfected once used and in between clients.
 These are the general steps taken when cleaning and disinfecting **non-critical and semi-critical items**
 Always follow the disinfectant solution and equipment manufacturer's instructions for proper use.



Keep record for any time disinfectant is used, prepared, or discarded

Low Level Disinfection To be used on:

- Non-Critical Items
- Items that contact but do not penetrate intact skin
- Items that do not contact blood or body fluids
- e.g. work surfaces, combs, brushes, service trays

Intermediate/High Level Disinfection To be used on:

- Semi-Critical Items
- Items that may accidentally penetrate intact skin
- Items that contact blood or body fluids
- e.g. laser wands, tweezers, grater-style foot files, foot baths

PERSONAL SERVICE SETTINGS: CLEAN, STERILIZATION FLOW CHART

All reusable tools and surfaces must be cleaned and sterilized once used and in between clients.

These are the general steps taken when cleaning and sterilizing **Critical Items, Items intended to penetrate intact skin or Items that hold sterile items**

Always follow the disinfectant solution and equipment manufacturer's instructions for proper use.

STEP 1:

CLEAN

STEP 2:

RINSE

STEP 3:

**AIR
DRY**

STEP 4:

STERILIZE

STEP 5:

STORE

Loosen dirt and debris using detergent, clean water, and a clean brush

Rinse off tools with warm water

*Air dry items in an area away from contamination
Do not wipe items to dry*

Use an appropriate and approved sterilizer (i.e. autoclave, dry heat)

Store all sterilized tools into a disinfect/sterilized clean container with a cover
